Information from previous weeks

- Closed Campus Reminder Thanks to our families for following our District/School COVID Safety Plan. As noted on each entrance, family/parent entry to the school is by appointment only. If you need to drop off items for your children, please park by the office/staff door and call the office and we will come out to get the items. If students leave early they also exit via the staff/office door. Meetings must be pre-arranged and if booking through the teacher, the teacher will notify the office. For further clarification please see the District Safety Plan, which is linked at the bottom of Laker News, or call the office.
- **Cold Weather** It looks like winter is back! Students will continue to be outside on most days. We do not have a temperature cut-off for inside days, we look at the ambient temperature, wind chill and the amount of time that students will be outside. We assess this throughout the school day and try to get students outside even on colder days for short amounts of time. Whenever possible we want students to get fresh air throughout the day. We reference the Environment Canada Wind Chill Chart http://bit.ly/2XQRyHP Thanks to families for their help in ensuring students have appropriate winter gear.
- School Exposure Letters During the break the school exposure letters were shared as per the process below by Northern Health. Upon return to school on January 4th, we will be returning to the exposure letter process that was happening prior to the break, in which families are notified first by the school with a potential exposure letter, and Northern Health will follow up with a post to their website.




Dear Parents/Guardians,


