#### Conditions of borrowing from the toy lending library:

> A Care Provider may borrow items for the lending period of:

To notify CCRR if I close my facility or if I move to another location.

- 2 weeks for topic boxes (up to 2 topic boxes per loan)
- 1 month for all other items (equipment, resources, or toys) (up to 6 items per loan)

(Maximum limit of no more than 8 items total per loan)

- A Parent/Student will borrow items for the lending period of:
  - 2 weeks for topic boxes (only 1 topic boxes per loan)
  - 1 month for all other items (equipment, resources, or toys) (up to 3 items per loan)

(Maximum limit of no more than 4 items total per loan)

- Borrowers are responsible for any damage (beyond everyday wear and tear)
- > There will be a minimum \$10.00 fee for items not clean when returned.
- > Borrowers may have 2 renewals from the date of each loan. Items not returned after the second renewal are subject to a late fee of \$1.00 per day until returned.





#### Fun Activities for Summer 2023!



#### Cloud Jars! >

#### Materials you'll need:

- Colored water (food coloring and water),
- A clear jar/glass/vase with water in it,
  - Shaving foam
  - An eyedropper/pipette

#### How to:

Squirt shaving cream on top of the water.

Talk with your child/students about how the shaving cream is representing a "cloud" and that they are going to be filling the "cloud" with water to see what happens.

Ask them what they think will happen

Let the child drip coloured water on top of the "cloud"

#### Tear Free Bubble Recipe

14 cup baby shampoo (tear free)
