### **Ongoing Items**

- Drop off/Pick up/Bussing: Students are expected to take their regular bus as we do not have enough supervision for non early/late bus students to come early or to stay late. Students are okay to play after school as long as they are being supervised by a parent. We do expect students to be picked up by 3:05pm when our teacher supervisor has completed their supervision. Drop-off of students should not be earlier than 8:30 because we do not have adequate supervision prior to that time. The buses are full and cannot take extra riders so please remind your children to take their regular bus home each night.
